

GRF OPERATING RULES
Bridge Room



A. General

1. Residents and guests must sign in upon arrival at the facility.
2. Residents and guests must clean up the area after use and return all equipment to the proper place.
3. The bridge room is for playing duplicate and progressive bridge during regular clubhouse hours.
4. The Bridge Club running the organized bridge game/tournament establishes fees to play.
5. Guest fees shall be collected on behalf of and paid daily to GRF in accordance with the schedule of guest fees.
6. Assigned game directors run the games and are paid by the club.
7. Club meetings and events do not have priority use. Club tournaments and events must be approved by the Recreation and Special Events Department to take priority at the facility. Please reference the Recreation and Special Events Department policy for tournament guidelines.

B. Guests

1. Residents must play bridge at the same time as their guest(s) but are not required to play at the same table; otherwise, residents must always accompany their guest(s).
2. Each bridge-playing resident is limited to two guests per session per day, not to exceed four guests per day. Guests must be at least 10 years of age.

Note: The Recreation and Special Events Department reserves the right to review and adjust the operating rules to accommodate the needs of the community. All GRF policies and procedures apply to the use of the amenities. GRF is authorized to take disciplinary action against a member found in violation of the operating rules.
