In other USTA competitions, the coveted Gold Ball was won by Tennis Club members **Norm and Gail Ashbrooke** in the USTA National Husband-Wife Open. They competed in the 70 + 75 combined age group. That victory came on the heels of Norm's outstanding results in Croatia, representing the US team. Let's let him tell it:

"Gail and I were in Croatia for 16 days. The first week I played on the US team representing players ages 75-79. There were 21 nations in our age division. The US came in fourth, so my three teammates and I received a copper medal. Spain, Germany and Canada won the gold, silver and bronze medals. It was an amazing experience playing on the red clay courts against the best senior players in the world. Our team defeated Ireland, Sweden and Australia before losing 2-1 against Spain, the eventual champions.

"During the second week, I played in the Individual World Championships. There were over 70 players in my age category alone. I was seeded 10th in the tournament, and in the round of 16, I defeated the No. 6 seed in 3 sets. In the quarterfinals I lost to the No. 1 seed from Spain 4-6, 3-6. The No. 1 seed was also the No. 1 ranked player in the world in my age category. His name is Jairo Velasco Ramirez, a former top-50 professional player. Altogether I played against competitors from 8 different countries: Ireland, Sweden, Canada, Switzerland, Spain, France, Austria and Argentina. It was truly a memorable adventure."
