Notes from the President:

Recycling tennis balls is now a reality at the Tennis Club. We have partnered with a nonprofit called RecycleBalls, which is dedicated to finding a use for old tennis balls and keeping them out of the trash. Since 2017, they have saved almost 16 million balls from decomposing in landfills. Considering that every year 125 million tennis balls wind up in landfills — and it takes 400 years for rubber waste to decompose — their mission is not just admirable but vital.

You may have noticed the two green and yellow RecycleBalls boxes by the Clubhouse. One is for "Dead Balls" and the other, labeled "Ball Machine," is for balls that are still useable. Wet, soft, squishy balls belong in the "Dead" box; those that still have some bounce go in "Ball Machine."

Now we understand it would be more convenient to place these boxes on the courts, but it still rains in Southern California and cardboard, even the heavy-duty kind, inevitably breaks down, ruining any useable balls that have been collected. For players who don't pass the Clubhouse RecycleBalls boxes, we plan to place additional receptacles closer to the courts or by the entry gates. They will also be labeled "Dead Balls" and "Ball Machine," and we ask that you toss in used balls as you pass by. Volunteers, including board members, will routinely offload these collected balls into the larger RecycleBalls boxes. And those collected for the "Ball Machine" will replenish the machines, replacing dead balls that will go into that recycle box. So what happens after the boxes are filled to capacity with the 200 balls they hold? We ship them back to RecycleBalls and they handle the rest. Some of the balls are sold to dog owners who are encouraged to recycle them back at no cost. But the organization's main goal is to reuse the balls in a variety of green products. RecycleBalls has invested in technology to grind up the tennis balls they've collected. What emerges is a processed natural crumb rubber that can be incorporated in the production of playground turf, traffic safety equipment and landscaping mulch. Already RecycleBalls crumb rubber is being used in the construction of equestrian turf and, would you believe, tennis courts.

We welcome all our members and guests to join us in this worthwhile project. **Don't trash that ball** — **Recycle It!**
