- All board meetings are replayed following Thursday at 1:30 p.m. and following week on Wednesday at 6 p.m.





# Marketing/Communications Email Lists



Village Management Services, Inc.

- Email address on file with Resident Services does not subscribe you to “What’s Up in the Village” eblast—you must request subscription
- Residents must “opt in” and can “opt out” of email lists used on third-party platforms for communications division marketing purposes
- Update email for marketing email messages by emailing **[info@lagunawoodsvillage.com](mailto:info@lagunawoodsvillage.com)**
- Clicking “Unsubscribe” at bottom of any Village email message stops receipt; however, per FCC regulations VMS cannot resubscribe on your behalf (you must contact our vendor); email **[info@lagunawoodsvillage.com](mailto:info@lagunawoodsvillage.com)**

# Association Membership List



Village Management Services, Inc.

- Official membership email list lives with Resident Services for business purposes other than Village marketing and communications emails—the two are not linked
- Update your membership information (mailing address, phone, email address, etc.) by emailing Resident Services at **[residentservices@vmsinc.org](mailto:residentservices@vmsinc.org)**

# Association Membership List, cont'd



Village Management Services, Inc.

- Association membership address/email accessible to general membership via a records request through CEO/GM office
- Civil Code §5220 allows members to make contact information inaccessible to general membership
- Must notify association of wishes:
  - Fill out opt-out authorization form in April or November business plan packets (mailed or emailed)
  - Log in to resident portal at **lagunawoodsvillage.com**
  - All options detailed in opt-out authorization form in mailed or emailed business plans

# Preferred Delivery Method



Village Management Services, Inc.

- Senate Bill 392 mandates that an association deliver a document in accordance with a member's preferred delivery method
- To update your preference for 2025, populate and return the preferred delivery method form in April or November 2024 mailing with your preference(s)
  - Or email your preference (valid email **or** mailing address, two valid email addresses or two mailing addresses) to **information@vmsinc.org**
- Paperless option can save approximately \$7.50 per manor in printing and postage for spring and fall mailings; if 12,000 manors went paperless, this would save \$90,000 in one year
- Preferred delivery method list does not affect association membership mailing list
