ADOPTION PROGRAM

Our organization was started because our local animal shelter does not have space for abandoned and/or lost pets. Laguna Woods is a retirement community and our residents often end up going to assisted living or passing away, and kitties are left homeless. There was a real need for someone to step up and fill this need, so we established a network of foster homes, a website and a Petfinder site to advertise our kitties needing homes. We provide an initial vet exam immediately and pay for services including medical care, shots, spay and neuter, etc.

To relinquish... is to explain and forgive the reason for giving up your cat. We have the form and the procedure. It's free, A donation of \$50 is appreciated. Cats must have vet records and have been seen by a vet recently..shots up to date etc.

A cat that is brought into our program will either go into foster care or remain with their owner until adopted. Once the kitty is in our program, we promote the kitty through our website, the Globe, and our YouTube channel where videos showoff these beautiful furry creatures.

Pets adopted from rescue groups typically cost less than pets purchased or even acquired for free—once you add in the cost of a vet exam, vaccinations, deworming and other "extras" included in your adoption fee, you'll probably be surprised what a bargain an adopted pet really is!

If for some reason you don't find who you're looking for right away, don't be discouraged. We receive new kitties all the time, so keep checking back with us. Also, we can put you on a waiting list for that 'special' cat you are looking for.

We post out Cats on two sites at least, (adoptapet and petfinders), with photos, videos, descriptions and contact info.
