New RCLW Email Service – Are you receiving our emails?

The Republican Club has switched to a new email service, Mailchimp, that is widely used by clubs, non-profits, and commercial entities. It enables the successful delivery and monitoring of email to a large distribution list. It also allows us to use a mailbox through the Republican Club's internet domain.

Our new email address is RCLW@republicancluboflagunawoods.org

If you have not received any of our emails from this address, they could have been stopped by your email's spam filter. Please **check your spam folder** (sometimes called "junk" folder) and add our address to your contact list. It is a good idea to add us to your contact list in any case. This should prevent future problems with the spam filter.

A few people with **Gmail** accounts have reported missing emails from this new address. If you use Gmail and have not seen emails from the new address, please read on. **If you don't use Gmail, you can ignore the rest of this page.**

The emails are being delivered to Gmail addresses, we believe, but maybe not being seen by some because of Gmail's unique category system. The Gmail inbox contains two tabs by default, "Primary" and "Promotions." Emails from our new address will typically be assigned to the Promotions category, so they will appear under that tab and not the Primary tab. Unless you check the Promotions tab regularly, you will not see emails from our new address. If you don't want to check both tabs constantly, here are two other options.

- Move one of our new emails from the Promotions tab to the Primary tab and choose the option
 that pops up to "do this for future emails" from RCLW. Then, future RCLW emails will go to your
 primary tab and other promotional category emails will continue to go to the Promotions tab.
 Choose this option if you want to keep other promotional emails separate from your primary
 inbox.
- 2. Change a setting to allow the display of Promotions in your Primary tab, which then becomes your Inbox for both categories. A procedure for doing this is available as a separate handout entitled Gmail Category Display Change Procedure. This procedure is also located on the RCLW website under "Documents." Choose this option if you would like a more traditional inbox for all your incoming mail.

Note: The discussion above about Gmail categories applies to the Gmail online site (mail.google.com...) and the Gmail application for other devices. Applications like Microsoft Outlook, Apple Mail, and others do not display the Gmail categories in separate tabs, so RCLW email should appear as usual in their inboxes.
