

<u>AB2393– NEWPORT DUNES LEASE EXTENTION</u> will extend the lease for public trust lands at Newport Bay, so the County can have more flexibility to enhance public access and recreation opportunities.

<u>Ab 2766 -EARLY RELEASE TRANSPARENCY ACT</u> will make records at the Department of corrections and Rehabilitation pertaining to an inmate's early release subject to disclosure under the California Public Records Act.

AB 2912 - GAS PRICES ACT will promote transparency and accountability for the price drivers pay at the pump with monthly online updates on the change in gasoline cost.

CAN VENEZUELA'S SOCIALIST DISASTER BECOME OUR DISASTER?

Daniel DiMartino, Founder, Dissident Project was born in Venezuela one month before socialist tyrant Hugo Chavez took office, and he grew up as everything around him fell apart. The grocery store shelves were emptier each day, schools had fewer teachers each semester, his home began losing power and water frequently and, with each passing year, more of his family had friends migrated to other countries. Almost every week during his childhood he visited his maternal grandparents who emigrated to Venezuela. They told him about the rationing and how his grandfather dropped out of middle school to work in a candy factory. He visited his paternal grandparents, who were Italian and from whom he learned about the resistance against Benito Mussolini. From all four of them he learned of all the opportunities they encountered in Venezuela as they immigrated there in 1956, when it was the fourth richest country in the world. But the Venezuela he grew up in turned into something very different from the country that welcomed his grandparents—and that his parents lived in their whole lives.

Chavez planted the seeds of envy to get elected and then used his power to nationalize companies small and large, impose price and currency controls, and centralize government authority. To maintain his popularity, Chavez gave away free food, utilities, gasoline, home appliances, education, healthcare treatments, and countless goods and services. His socialist policies bankrupted the nation, leading to hyperinflation and widespread shortages, blackouts, and water scarcity. He packed the courts and purged the police, leading to skyrocketing crime, including robbery, homicide, and kidnappings.

Amid Venezuela's downfall, when his family went from earning thousands of dollars to just \$100 per month, he saw the light in his high school library—where he found a Spanish translation of Milton Friedman's book *Free to choose.* He began watching You Tube videos of Friedman, a former Young American's Foundation speaker. This led him to learn more about Ronald Reagan, Margaret Thatcher, and Friedrich Hayek and become interested in the United States. By his senior year of high school he became determined to attend college in America.

He left Venezuela in 2016. While in America he realized America was everything and more than he expected. He also began to recognize how serious the threat to freedom was. In attending college he was assigned to in student orientation was so-called "walk of privilege." If you were white or Christian. you took a step forward, but if you were black you took a step back. Women, Hispanics, and gays and lesbians also took steps back. Many more experiences showed him that American's colleges were indoctrinating students into believing in an ideology of oppression, and their main goal was to dismantle the freedom of enterprise that has allowed America to become richer than any society in human history.

He began speaking out about what happened to his native country. Everywhere he went, he tells the story of what he lived through in Venezuela—how socialist policies like nationalization, overregulation, deficit spending destroyed it—and debunk myths like the idea that Nordic countries are socialist paradises. In speaking before groups, he has answered questions far left-wing students who think socialism could work "if implemented correctly" and even persuaded many of them to understand that this would not—and has never been—the case. Many adult Americans tell me that they are worried about their country's future. He is hopeful because we ae putting up a fight that Venezuelans did not—the fight for the minds of the next generation. Through organizations like The Young America's Foundation they are making sure that young Americans know America is that "Empire of Liberty" that Jefferson dreamed of and that "shining city on a hill" that Ronald Reagan described.

We cannot let happen to us as happened to Venezuela —Socialist disaster! Socialism is the control of society not by individuals but by ownership and distribution by society –Marxism!! In Marxist doctrine, it is the coming between the capitalist stage and the communist stage in which private ownership of the means of production and distribution has been eliminated.
