planned for this year are new benches, sunshades and ball machines. These expenditures fall under VMS's equipment budget for this year, and the board has asked VMS to seek our input for future equipment buys as the budget cycle progresses. We have suggested chairs with back supports for the courts (in addition to the benches) and new fence covers. As for court resurfacing, it's scheduled for fall 2026, so minor repairs will be made as needed in the interim.

VMS recently began stepped-up monitoring of overall court usage. Please be sure to swipe/tap your membership card when you enter a gate *and also* use the green sign-in sheets for yourself and any guests. We don't want court usage to be undercounted by VMS! They will implement the following rules changes on a trial basis starting in June:

- For consistency, time limits on all courts will change to 1.5 hours when others are waiting
- An additional green sign-in sheet will be put by the entrance to Courts 9-10 to avoid undercounting players on reserved courts who use that back gate to enter the facility
- Time limits for ball machines will change to 1 hour to accommodate more users

For players who take part in Lorie's groups on Tuesday and Thursday mornings: Beginning May 28th Lorie will use the Court Reserve App (Events function) to sign up players. If you need help with Court Reserve, contact Lorie. She also asked us to remind everyone that the use of ball machines is by reservation only.

Things to Ponder:

VMS informed us they will not go ahead with a village-wide survey on tennis court usage, as they had suggested after a meeting with club members last December. They will consider feedback from the trial period of rules changes described above for their decisions going forward. The club can make suggestions, so if you have input please let us know. Take a minute to email us, or use the Suggestion Box in the clubhouse to give us your thoughts:

- If you use the ball machines, do you typically spend more or less than 1 hour hitting?
- Changing all court times to 1.5 hours while others are waiting provides consistency and simplifies court allocation. Do you agree with the 1.5-hour limit for all courts? **Yes or No**
- Regarding the multiple whiteboards used for walk-on courts: Would it be better to post one whiteboard for Courts 1-8 and a second whiteboard for Courts 9-10 located near those two reserved courts at the back of the facility? Yes or No

In response to the April "Things to Ponder" piece on opportunities to play tennis in groups, lessons and drills; we heard several comments in favor of drills and organized play along with some questions about group activities. We will pursue these topics at the next board meeting. Stay tuned.
