As you've probably noticed, we got VMS to add hi-vis tape to the legs protruding from the new bench/table sets and hooks to hang gear. Another issue is the erratic schedule of court washing. We have a commitment from VMS not to start before noon, but occasionally maintenance staff availability makes it hard to keep to the schedule. They assured us this was an exception.

We also appreciate your cooperation and patience with the temporary whiteboard for courts 1-6 and the lack of sign-in sheets by courts 9/10. If permanent solutions were in our control, they'd be done by now!

You may recall from the May meeting minutes that a local tennis team asked to use the tennis facility on weekday afternoons for approximately 10 months. We voiced our opposition as we felt it would negatively affect Village residents. We stayed engaged with CAC as the proposal was reconsidered. We are delighted to report the proposal has been rejected. Match Win!

The ball machine demo could have gone better, but the new Shot Maker machines are now in service. Keys are kept at Clubhouse 7. VMS has implemented security procedures requiring reservations, a signed liability waiver and a collateral item such as a state ID for each use. Additionally, we've been told the process to fill the part-time position at the tennis facility is still in the works, but it takes time. They are reviewing the job description and it's working its way through their system.



We also asked about a follow-up to our meeting on "groups" that Lorie used to manage in CourtReserve. VMS is considering a way forward for those groups that regularly require the use of more than one court. The goal is to accommodate players in a fair and consistent manner. On the issue of having a 1.5-hour time limit per court, the feedback has been positive. Having the actual "rules" rewritten to reflect that change is pending and may not occur until later this year when a full review is accomplished by VMS. We again asked for a separate sign-in station near courts 9/10.



### **Tournament Format**






- Only Men's and Ladies' doubles

Level of Play



### Day of the Week (choose all that work for you)




