Dear All,

Here are some important notes on the tournament:

1. The tournament has two Stages, Stage 1 is Round Robin competitions within each of the two groups. Each group has three teams. There are two courts for the two groups to play at the same time. Stage 2 is the playoff of the top two teams from each team for the championship. Every match is decided by the best two out of three and the third game will be only 15 points. The team not playing will take the responsibilities of the umpire, the sideline referee, and the score recorder. The reward for the champion team is \$60, the runner up \$30, and the third place \$18. If time not permits, the award ceremony will be held in Dining Room 2, CH1.

2. Reiterate of some major game rules:

- returning a serving ball with hands above the chest can only pass to teammates.
- a ball hit from the front court directly into the opposite court must possess a clear upperwards curve.
- touching the net during the play by any part of the body is illegal
- only the umpire and the sideline referee can decide whether a ball is outside or not
- when there is a disagreement on the ruling, Steve Q will make a final decision

3. The afterwards pizza party will be held in Dining Room 2, CH1. The club will provide pizzas, desserts, fruits, and beverages. All the club members, as well as their relatives/friends cheering for the games, are welcome to the party. In addition to the soft drinks donated by John Zhao, there will be ice cream bars donated by Steve Q, chicken bake from Costco donated by Ai Chen/Weix. The air fryer and thermo cups donated by Alice/Ron MCG will be shared by the video winners. Our new club member, A Liang, has donated 8 pieces of brand new jackets that will be distributed among all the party participants by drawing lots at the end of the party. Thanks to all the donors mentioned above and looking forward to a successful tournament!

4. The games will start at 5pm sharp, players are encouraged to arrive 15 minutes earlier to warm up

5. One or two volunteers are needed to pick up the pizzas at Costco around 6:30 pm before the tournament finishes. The volunteers shall be those who are not playing the games.
